

Subject: Disaffiliation of SLIET, Longowal from PTU, Jalandhar for awarding degrees in respect of courses run by the Institute- reg.




This is to inform you that the central Govt, on the advice of UGC, has declared "Sant Longowal Institute of Engineering & Technology (SLIET), Longowal -148 106, District -Sangrur, Punjab" as a Deemed-to-be University provisionally for a period of five years w.e.f. the date, the SLIET disaffiliates itself from the Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar, Punjab.

Accordingly all the new students enrolled with SLIET in respect of the courses run by the Institute will be awarded degrees etc. by SLIET, Longowal w.e.f. the academic session to be started from August, 2007 onwards.

As for the students who are already enrolled with SLIET prior to the date of this notification, they shall continue to be enrolled with the present affiliating University, namely the Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar which shall examine and award degrees to them on successful completion of the courses/ programmes they are pursuing at SLIET presently.

Therefore, Sant Longowal Institute of Engineering & Technology, Longowal-148 106, District- Sangrur, Punjab is, hereby, disaffiliating itself on the FIRST Day OF JUNE 2007 from the Punjab Technical University (PTU), Jalandhar for the sake of awarding all the degrees.
