1. Tender must be properly closed and envelop addressed to the Director, Sant Longowal Institute of Engineering & Technology, Longowal by designation and not by name. The Tender must be superscribed. "Tender for the **Supply of Electrical Material for Annual Repair & Maintenance for F/Y 2011-2012 at SLIET, Longowal** during the year 2011-2012 as called for in Tender no.....dated.....
.....". The Tender must reach the Director, SLIET, before.....A.M./P.M. on the date mentioned in the Tender notice.
2. In the event of the Tender being submitted by a firm it must be signed separately by each member thereof, or in the event of the absence of any partner it must be signed on his behalf by a person holding a power-of- attorney authorizing him to do so, in the case of a company the Tender should be executed in the manner laid down in the said company's Articles of Association. The signatures on the Tender should be deemed to be authorized signatures.
3. All the columns of the Tender form shall be duly, properly and exhaustively filled in. The rates and units shall not be over- written. Tender shall always be both in figures and words must quote rates for all items, otherwise his Tender shall be rejected.
4. Any omission in filling the columns of "units and rates" shall altogether debar a Tender from being considered.
5. No alteration should be made in any of the terms and conditions of the Tender by scoring out. No alteration or overwriting is permitted in the rates, No alteration will be allowed after the Tender is received by this office. The submitting Tender, no variation in the conditions shall be admissible. Any qualified, offer with the word such as subject to prior sale will be ignored. Ambiguity must be avoided in filling the Tender and the Language used in filling the Tender forms must be clear and precise. Tenders not complying with these conditions will be ignored.
6. A sum of **Rs. 30000/- (Rs. Thirty Thousand only)** must be deposited as EMD in the shape of Bank Draft in favor of the Director, SLIET & must accompany the Tender without which it will not be considered. If any successful Tenderer fails within the time fixed by the Director, SLIET to sign the contract on terms contained in the invitation for Tender, its Tender shall be rejected.
7. No Tender will be considered unless and until all the documents are properly signed. In the event of Tender being accepted the Tender will be converted into a contract which will be governed by the condition in paras.....to.....read with these instructions to Tenderers.
8. The conditions of contract in schedule 'B' attached to Schedule 'A' should be returned to this office duly signed alongwith schedule 'A' otherwise the Tender will be ignored. In case , the date of opening falls on a holiday declared by the Institute, Tenders will be opened on the next working day, following the close day, at the scheduled time.
9. Any Tender which is not on the proper Tender form or is received late will not be considered. All disputes will be settled within the jurisdiction of the Head Quarters of Director, S.L.I.E.T. NO C/D form can be issued. However, Institute shall be allowed/charged only concessional rate of tax against submission of certificate in the prescribed Form.
10. 100% payment will be released within 30 days after receipt of stores/equipments in good condition, as per specifications of supply order and demonstration/installation to the satisfaction of the department at Institute's site by means of Cheque/demand draft. No other system of payment shall be acceptable even if quoted by any Tenderer.
11. Tenders/Offer of such of the firms which do not confirm to the aforesaid conditions will be ignored straight-way.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

SCHEDULE 'A'

1. Tender should be submitted alongwith EMD in the properly closed envelop duly superscribing Tender for **Category Electrical material** due on Security if any lying with the Institute will not be considered against this Tender.
2. Conditional, Telegraphic & Tender without EMD shall be rejected outrightly.
3. All Tenders rates will be deemed to be for F.O.R. SLIET Destination includes packing and forwarding charges and must not be "ex-godown", "ex-mills", etc.
4. The Tenders will be regarded as constituting an offer or offers open to acceptance in whole or in parts.
5. While quoting the rates all the parties should quote their sales tax registration Nos. in their offer and also certify that the product quoted by them is strictly according to N.I.T. failing which their offer will be ignored.
6. Excise and custom duties are exempted to the Institute in terms of Govt. Notification No.10/97 Central Excise 'dt' 1st March, 1997 and Notification No.51/96-customs dt.23.07.1996 respectively. If exemption is applicable under the notification, quote the rates accordingly.
7. The rates should be quoted for a complete unit with all accessories. Make of each accessories may be mentioned.
8. In cases where full specifications are not incorporated in the enquiry or where alternative specifications are quoted, or the suppliers own specifications should be stated in full for the articles quoted for. Any illustrative literature available duly stamped and signed should also accompany.
9. In all cases the Country manufacture and unit of measurement must be prominently stated. The unit should usually be the one stated in the enquiry.
10. All containers will be deemed to be non-returnable, unless when specifically stated otherwise in Tender.
11. The minimum period of delivery from date of placing the order should be specified.
12. All Tender will be deemed valid for at least one year from and excluding the date of opening of Tenders.
13. The inspection of the goods will be carried out by the authorized officer at destination, if required and rejected goods will have to be removed by supplier within 10 days of dispatch of advice from the Institute, failing which the goods will lie at his risk.
14. The rejected goods must be replaced by supplier (s) within 15 days of the dispatch by the Director, S.L.I.E.T. of a registered notice intimating that the goods have been rejected failing which the Director, S.L.I.E.T. will be entitled to make risk purchases without any further reference to the supplier (s).
15. A sum of Rs. 30000/- (Rs. Thirty Thousand only) in the form of EMD shall have to be deposited by Tenderer as performance guarantee in favor of Director, SLIET from their Bankers along with the Tender, irrespective of the total amount of supply order to the Tenderer in whole or in parts. This amount will be released after expiring 12 months after the date of delivery of first installment of supply. In case the Tenderer fails to get any supply order being not able to attain L1 for any of the quoted items, its EMD shall be returned within 15 days of the date of opening of Tender.
16. The supply must be completed satisfactorily within the stipulated period, failing which penalty @ ½ % per week on the value of supply order will be imposed without any notice.
17. In case rates are good for a certain period, postings of the acceptance on the last day will be acceptable to the Tenderer.
18. In case of Controlled goods by the Government the Tender must be sent subject to control rate and other conditions and they will be paid at the controlled rate offered by them whichever is lower.
19. In case of any dispute; the decision of the Director, SLIET shall be final and binding on Tender.
20. The contractor shall dispatch material "freight paid" in all cases where their offer in F.O.R. Destination. In the event of their failure to do so a penalty of 10% per annum shall be charged on the amount paid as freight by the Director, SLIET on their behalf in addition to recovery of amount of freight paid.
21. All above conditions will be enforced, unless with order of Director, SLIET are obtained relaxing any specific condition in any specific instance.
22. The Tender not strictly in accordance with the above conditions are liable to be rejected without consideration.

23. Without prejudice to other rights of the Director, SLIET the contractor shall be liable to pay at the rate of ten percent of the value of the order by way of liquidated damages which will be recoverable from any amount due to the contractor whether under this or any other contractor.
24. The Director, SLIET does not bind himself to accept the lowest Tender and reserves to himself the right to reject any or all Tenders without assigning any reasons, whatsoever. He may also increase or decrease the quantity of items.
25. No Tender will be considered unless and until all the documents are properly signed.
26. In the event of Tender being accepted the Tender will be converted into a contract which will be governed conditions of the contract. The instructions to Tenderers shall also form part of the contract.
27. The quoted rates in no case shall be exceeding the M. R.P. Responsibility of any legal complications arising out of this action of the Tenderer will be its own responsibility.

SCHEDULE 'B'

CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1. This contract is to last from **April 2011 to 31 March 2012** but in the Event of any breach of the agreement at any time on the part of the contractor, the contract may be terminated summarily by the Director, Sant Longowal Institute of Engineering & Technology, (S.L.I.E.T.) without compensation to the contractor.

Any change in constitution of the firm shall be notified forthwith by the contractor in writing to the authorities sanctioning the contract and such change shall not relieve any former member of the firm from any liability under the contract.

No new partner/ partners shall be accepted into the firm by the contractor in respect of this contract unless he/they agree to abide by all its term, conditions and deposit with the officer sanctioning the contract a written agreement to this effect. The contractor's receipt or acknowledgement or that of any partners subsequently accepted as above shall bind all of them and will be a sufficient discharge for any of the purpose of the contract.

2. The contractor will supply nothing but genuine articles. Described in column 2 of Schedule A, in such quantities as may be entered therein or supply orders placed from time to time during the period of contract. The quantities of stores given in the Tender are approximately, only.
3. The articles to be supplied under this contract will be of the quality equal and answerable in every respect to the specification given in the list accompanying with the Tender and approved by Engineer-In-Charge. The contractor shall be responsible for all complaints as regards the quality. In case of dispute regarding quality of articles, the decision of the Engineer-In-Charge will be final and binding on the contractor to any laboratory for chemical analysis and the cost thereof will be borne by Tenderer/Contractor.
4. The Engineer-In-Charge may, by notice in writing call upon the contractor to supply additional articles to serve as sample, as upon such notice in writing the contractor shall at his own cost be bound to supply additional samples, such additional samples being in all respects of the same quality as the sample first supplied.
5. The contractor will be responsible for damage or loss in transit and replace goods broken or lost within 10 days from the date of notice thereof.
7. Conditions as to time for performance whether laid down herein or in any Supply order shall always be regarded as the essence of the contract.
8. The Director, S.L.I.E.T. of his nominee or any of the experts attached to the Institute or person duly authorized in writing by the Director, SLIET shall have the power to inspect the stores. Before, during or after manufacture, collection, dispatch, transit or arrival and to reject the same or any part or portion after the written approval of the Director SLIET if he or they be not satisfied that the same is equal or according to the specification as per Tender notice submitted. The contractor shall not charge or be paid for supplies rejected as above and such supplies shall be removed by the contractor at once and at his expense. He shall neither claim nor be entitled to payment for any damage that rejected supplies may suffer from any harm whatsoever incidental to a full and proper examination and lest of such supplies. Institute shall not be under liability whatever for rejected supplies and the same will be at the contractor's risk. Rejected supplies shall be removed by the contractor within ten days after notice has been issued to him of such rejection, and failing such removal rejected goods will be at contractor's risk and Institute may charge the contractor rent for the space occupied by such rejected goods.
9. The contractor shall provide without any extra charge all materials, tools. Labour and assistance of every kind which the aforesaid officer may consider necessary for any test or examination which he may require to be made on the contractor's premises and shall pay all cost attendance thereon. In the case of stores inspected at maker's premises the maker shall provide all facilities including testing appliances, for making necessary tests other than special test or independent tests. Failing the facilities at the own premises for making the test the contractor shall bear the cost of carrying out test elsewhere. The contractor shall bear also provide and deliver free of charge at such place as the aforesaid officer may direct such materials as he may require to tests by

chemical analysis or independent testing machine. If for the purpose of determining the quality of stores the aforesaid officer finds it necessary to have the stores tested at the test house or laboratory, expenses incidental to the test shall be borne by the contractor. On the failure of the contractor to pay the expenses within ten days of the receipt of intimation in this behalf, Director shall have the right to deduct if not deposited within 10 days, the Director, SLIET may treat the default as a breach of contract and proceed accordingly without further notice. Further, the aforesaid officer shall have the right to put all articles or materials to such tests as he may think proper for the purpose of ascertaining whether the same are in accordance with the specifications or sealed sample mentioned in the Tender and to cut out or off or destroy a portion not exceeding 2 percent from each delivery for such purpose. The quantity so cut out or off and or destroyed as aforesaid shall be replaced by the contractor free of charge.

10. Packing cases, containers, gunny packages, etc. which may be used for purposes of packing and which are delivered with stores will not be returned and paid of unless specially stipulated, and then at contractor's expense.
11. Unless otherwise specified in a Supply Order, bills for the whole of the goods referred to in each supply order in duplicate, will be prepared and submitted by the contractor to the consignee for direct payment. The full amount will be paid on receipt of stores in good condition after their verification as regards specifications, etc.
12. (i) With every dispatch of goods or material under this contract, in voice I n duplicate, will be prepared by the contractor. Invoices in duplicate, are to be sent by the contractor to the consignee shown in the Supply Order, the duplicate to be returned by the consignee with the quantities or number received duly noted thereon.

(ii) Railway Receipt will be forwarded to the consignee immediately after dispatch of stores. Should any demurrage charges be incurred owing to delay on the part of the contractor in forwarding the railways receipt, the amount of such charges will be deducted from the bill.

(iii) The contractor shall dispatch material: Freight paid" in all cases where their offer is for destination. In the event of their failure to do so a penalty of 10 percent will be charged on the amount paid as freight by the consignee on their behalf.

(iv) All dispatches by rail will be made at Railway risk at the expense of the consignee (except by firm who have quoted rates. F.O.R. destination) unless the supply order provides instruction to dispatch at owner's risk in which case al responsibility for loss in transit will be with the consignee.

(v) This is subject to the condition that the materials are securely packed by the suppliers in sound containers and the consignment is accepted by the carriers without any adverse remarks as to the packing or the condition of the containers. In case of any adverse remarks, the responsibility of the losses in transit will rest with the suppliers. Subject of these condition the contractor will not be entitled to charge or be paid for supplies broken lost or damaged in transit The Director, SLIET will be the authority to determine whether of not the breakage, loss or damage was caused through the contractor's negligence and the decision of the Director, S.L.I.E.T. of some other officer acting on his behalf shall be final and conclusive against the contract. Such rejected supplies shall be removed by the contractor at his own expense.

(vi) If during the currency of the contract the specification of any article or articles to the supplied their under be changed the contractor shall continue to comply with demands for the supply of the said article or articles in accordance with the new specifications at a rate to be mutually agreed to in writing at the time of such change and in default of such agreement the contract in so far as it relates to the said articles or articles in respect or which no agreement has been arrived at, shall terminate but no such change shall affect the supply of any other article under the contract or entitle the contractor to any compensation
13. In the event of withdrawal or discontinuance of any article or articles and consequent ceasing of or reduction in demand the contractor shall not be entitled to any compensation. Director will, however, make all reasonable endeavors to give warning of any impending complete withdrawal or of any reduction seriously affecting quantities likely to be required under contract.
14. The time for and date of delivery or dispatch stipulated in a supply order shall be deemed to be the essence of the contract and should the contractor fail to deliver or dispatch any consignment within the period prescribed for such delivery or dispatch, stipulated in the supply order, the delayed consignment will be subject to ½ % percent penalty per consignment per week recoverable on the value of the items supplied. In case of non-payment by the contractor recovery will be made from his bills or amount of earnest money deposit or security deposited with the Director, S.L.I.E.T., provided also that:-

- (a) No recovery of penalty will be made if the delayed supplies are accepted by extending the delivery period by the Director, S.L.I.E.T.
 - (b) The Director, S.L.I.E.T will allow extension upto two weeks on the request of the supplier by recording in writing that the exception circumstances were beyond the control of the supplier and there was no loss to the institute but where the delay on the part of the supplier is more than two weeks the mater for extension of delivery period will be decided by the Director, S.L.I.E.T., on satisfaction that there are genuine reasons for delay on the part of the supplier and that no loss will result to the Institute in case extension in delivery period is allowed in each individual purchase case exceeding two weeks but upto eight weeks. No. further extension will be allowed.
 - (c) On the failure of the supplier to make supply within the extended period on receipt of such information in the office of the Director, S.L.I.E.T., risk purchase at the cost of supplier will be made by the Director, S.L.I.E.T. The difference of exceeds of cost thus incurred will be recovered from the supplier in a suitable manner and even, and even from his pending bills, earnest money or security whichever is available. This procedure will be adopted after sending registered notice to the supplier to supply stores within 15 days. Directors, S.L.I.E.T., reserve the right to forfeit the EMD and to place the firm under the panel of black listed firms.
15. The contractor acknowledges that he has made himself fully acquainted with all the conditions and circumstances under with the supplies required under the contract will have to be made of furnished and with all the terms, clauses, conditions, specifications and other details of the contract and the contractor, shall not plead ignorance or any of those as excuse incase of complaint against or to rejection of supplies Tendered by him or with a view to asking for encashment of any rates agreed to the contract or to evading and of his obligation under the contract.
 16. No payment will be made in advance for any supplies under this contract.
 17. In the event of the contractor failing duly and properly to fulfill or committing breach of any of any of the terms and conditions of this contract or repeatedly supplying goods liable to rejection hereunder of failing, declining, neglecting or delaying to comply with any demand or requisition or otherwise not executing the same in accordance with the terms of this contract or if the contractor or his agents or employees being guilty of fraud in respect of the contract of any other contract entered to by the contractor or any of his partners or representatives thereof with Institute directing, giving, promising of offering any bribes, gratuity, gift, loan, perquisite, reward or advantages pecuniary or otherwise to any person in the employment of the Institute in any way relating to such officers or person or persons, office or employment or it the contractor or any of his partners, become insolvent or apply for relief as insolvent debtor commence any insolvency proceeding of make any composition with his/their creditors or attempts to do so then without prejudice to Institute's right and remedies otherwise, Director, SLIET shall be entitled to terminate this contract forthwith forefeet the security and to blacklist the contractor and purchase or procure or arrange otherwise at the contractor's risk and at the absolute discretion of the Director, SLIET as regard the manner place or time of such purchases, such supplies as have not been supplied or have been rejected under this agreement or are required subsequently by the Director, SLIET there under in case purchase or supplies together with all incidental charges or expenses, shall be recoverable from the contractor on demand, and the contractor shall not be entitled to benefit from any profit which may thus accrue to Institute. The termination of this contract in whole or part under these conditions shall not be affected by the acceptance, meanwhile or subsequently, of supplies accepted or made at any time whether in ignorance of the termination or otherwise.
 18. If any question, difference or objection whatsoever shall arise in any way connected with or arising out of this instrument or the meaning or operation of any part thereof or the rights, duties or liabilities of either party than save in so far as the decision of any such matter is here in before provided for and has been so decided, every such matter including whether its decision has been otherwise provided for and/ or whether it has been finally decided accordingly or whether the contract should be terminated or has been rightly terminated in whole or part and as regards the rights and obligations of the parties as the result of such termination shall be decided by the Director, S.L.I.E.T. and decision shall be final and binding.
